- She was born in 1943 and now she is74 years old.
- She doesn't remember much because she was so young.
- They had to leave the Karelian Isthmus in Summer 1943 because of the Continvation War.
- They were evacuated when she was six months old.
- Their family of nine persons took their cat, icon and fork with them and left.
- They came from Hautavaara to Juuka and they were in host family but after two years they built their own house.

- They lived in a house that had only one big room.
- The locals weren't very friendly when they came.
- Language was a problem because evacuees spoke Karelian and others spoke Finnish and it was hard to learn it.
- In school Kaarina was bullied because she had a different religion. Finnish people were Lutheran and evacues were Orthodox.
- Adapting was hard and Kaarina had to repeat her first grade at school.
- Inspite of all these difficulties and problems, she has visited her roots in Karelia
