Gulf War



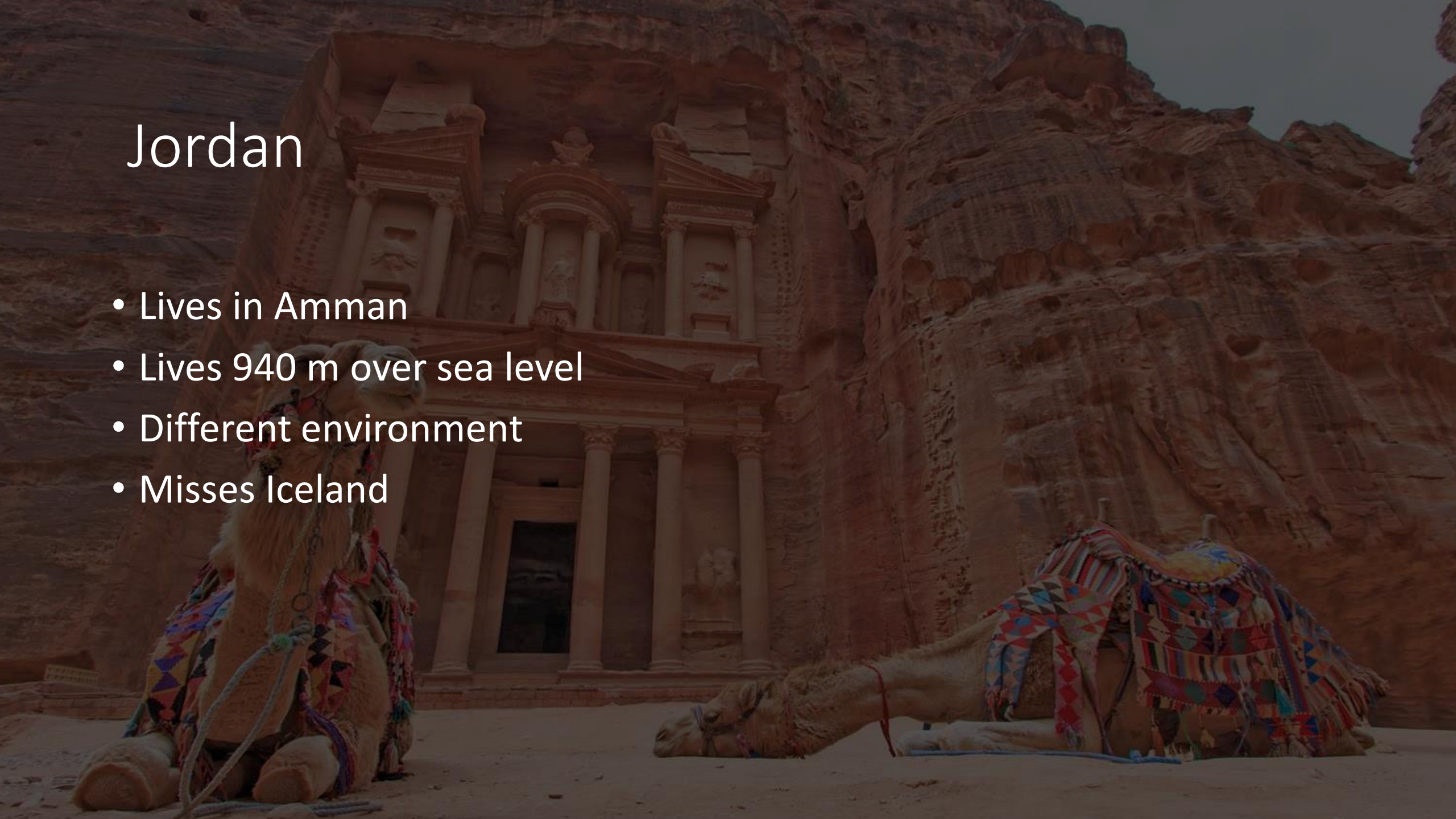
2 August 1990 – 28 February 1991

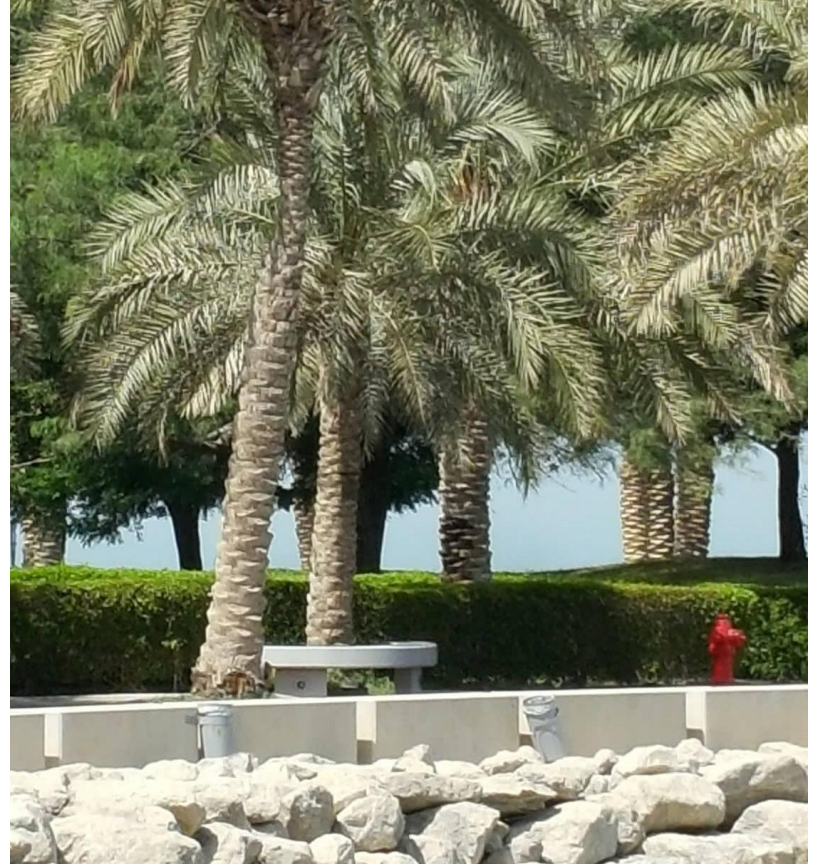
Iraq invaded Kuwait
